Research, Policy And Impact

Professor Aiken co led a White House research team during the Obama Administration's initiative on technology-facilitated human trafficking. She advises the UK government's Online Safety Data Initiative that brings together government, academia, industry and civil society stakeholders. Her Safety Tech work with Paladin Capital Group includes the Safety Tech report series, and she contributes to the **Global Cybersecurity Forum**. Coverage of her research includes **the Wall Street Journal**.

Mary's decorated career began with the Cyberpsychology Research Centre and evolved into an international agenda linking academia, policy and investment. Her bestselling book *The Cyber Effect* helped mainstream the science of human online behaviour, while *CSI: Cyber* introduced the field to a wider audience.
